<u>Judicial Ethics Opinion JE 106</u>

January 12, 2001

QUESTION:

A judicial candidate, subject to election, has been requested to contribute to his or her political party. May the candidate do so?

DISCUSSION:

Canon 5C(1)(a)(iii), 2000 Kan. Ct. R. Annot. 491, provides that

"A judge or a candidate subject to public election may, except as prohibited by law ...contribute to a political organization."

ANSWER:

We conclude that the judicial candidate may properly contribute to his or her political party, subject to any limitations that may be provided by law.
